

Geography Key Stage 3

At Key Stage 3, students follow a curriculum based on 6 different themes. Students in Year 7 and 8 explore a different topic within each theme. Themes include: My Places, The Changing World Places, Far Away and Diverse Places, Risky Places, The Threatened World and The Interacting World. The lessons follow an enquiry based approach encouraging students to ask questions about the world, find out answers and suggest solutions. Lessons aim to ignite students' geographical imaginations and increase their awareness of local and global issues.

Fieldwork and Enrichment trips at Key Stage 3

In Years 7 and 8 we aim to develop fieldwork and enquiry skills. We offer a range of local fieldwork opportunities including:

- Local area fieldwork in school grounds and Hookstone Drive area investigating the quality of the environment, rivers and climate
- Year 8 Malham – Studying the impacts of tourism on a honeypot site
- Festival of Science hosted at Leeds University
