

Key Stage 3

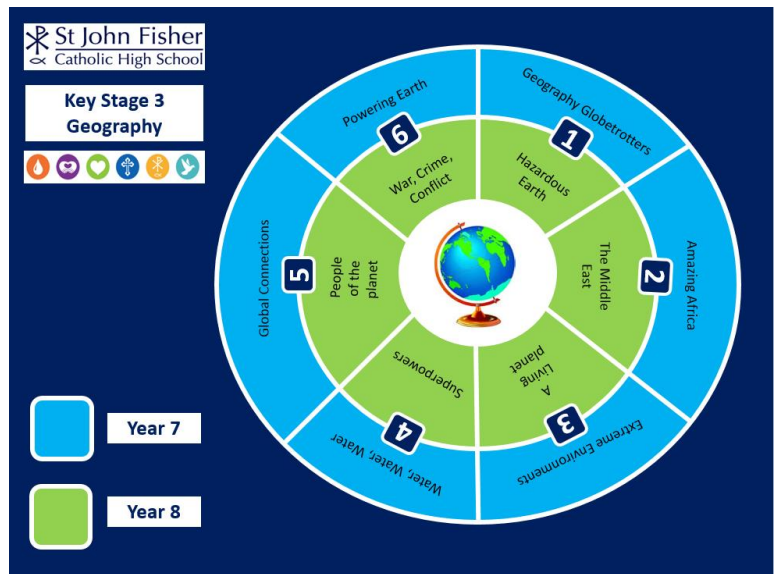
