NOTES RE Y10 MOCK EXAMINATIONS

- Students need to be outside Reception at least 15 minutes before the start of their exam if this is being held in the Main Hall. As most exams start either at 9.00am or 1.30 pm you will need to be outside your exam room or reception at around 8.45am for morning exams or 1.15pm for afternoon exams. Students do not need to go to their forms to register prior to a morning exam as we will use the seating plan to note any absences. For exams starting at 11.30, please arrive at 11.15am.
- Exam seating plans will be displayed outside Reception for students to check which seat/room they have been allocated for their exam.
- **There is no room for bags in the Main Hall** and so these will need to be left in the bag store at the front of the school and collected at the end of the exam. The bag store is padlocked once all bags have been placed in it. If you have an exam in the Gym or another room then you should take your bags with you and the invigilators will instruct you where to leave them.
- **Mobile phones, ipods, watches, mp3/4 players are not to be brought into the Exam Hall.** Anyone caught with a mobile phone in their possession during their mock exams will have it confiscated and the incident reported to Mrs Langstaff. In your actual GCSE exams penalties are very severe for being caught with a mobile phone etc and could result in you losing all your marks for that exam/subject.
- You are not allowed to bring food or drink into the Exam Hall except for water. This should be in a clear plastic bottle with all labels removed. Chewing gum is not allowed.
- There should be no talking once you enter the Exam Hall to sit your exam.
- It is your responsibility to bring the appropriate equipment with you for the exam you are about to sit. All items should be in a transparent pencil case or clear plastic bag. Calculators can be used for Geography, Bus Studies, D&T Electronics & Science exams as well as the Maths Calculator paper so do not forget to bring one (**without the lid**) if you take these exams.
- If you feel unwell during an exam, you should put your hand up to attract the invigilator's attention.
- Students should check their school uniform is correct before entering the Exam Hall to sit their exams.
- At the end of your exam you must remain seated until told to leave the Exam Hall. Please leave the room in silence and show consideration to other students who may still be working.
- Students with clashes on the timetable should speak to Mrs Haley for confirmation of when they are sitting their clash exams.
