Year 10 Great Yorkshire Show 2017

A visit to the Great Yorkshire Show is being organised for Year 10. The trip has been very successful in previous years and is an end of year treat to acknowledge the hard work which the vast majority of the year group have put into their studies throughout the year.

We will be visiting on **Tuesday 11th July**. The cost is **£7 per pupil payment to be made via parent pay by Friday 9th June**. If you are having difficulty logging on please email flydon@sjfchs.org.uk you will need to tick the consent box on parent pay. **Anyone wanting to buy tickets after this date will be charged £10.**

Below are more details about the arrangements for the day.

- On the day of the trip pupils will assemble after morning registration and walk down the school field to the showground. Once at the showground pupils will be shown where to meet at the end of the day/where to see a member of staff if there is an emergency. Pupils will then be able to visit attractions in groups. A member of SJF staff will always be available at the meeting point in case of emergencies. All pupils will wear a wristband containing a contact telephone number in case of emergencies. At the end of the visit all pupils will meet with staff back at the meeting point where a register will be taken before walking back to school in time for school transport.
- NO PUPIL IS ALLOWED TO GO HOME EARLY OR TO LEAVE THE SHOWGROUND DURING THE DAY UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY A MEMBER OF STAFF.
- In the event of school transport arriving late in the morning, a member of staff will remain in school to escort those pupils affected to the showground.
- As the event is largely outdoors, pupils must dress appropriately for the weather, having sunhats and sun cream if hot and coats if wet. Footwear needs to be suitable for walking around the large site. Girls should ensure their clothing is modest. Pupils inappropriately dressed will be challenged and may be asked to stay in school for the day. All pupils need either a packed lunch or money to purchase food. It is advisable that all pupils carry water. Whilst there is an opportunity to spend money, it is perfectly possible to engage in many free activities.
