Dear Parent/Guardian

Re: Somme Trip Parents Evening

I am writing to thank you for completing your prompt payments for the Somme Trip taking place from Friday 8th July until Tuesday 12th July 2015 and to inform you about the upcoming parents evening for the trip. This will be taking place on Wednesday 15th June starting at 6pm promptly in the sixth form dining room. I expect the evening to last no more than half an hour and would request that you enter the school via the sixth form entrance which is to the right of the main reception.

Additionally, it would be extremely beneficial for the trip if you have any information regarding relatives who were involved in the war as there is the possibility to visit a variety of different cemeteries close to the memorials that are already on the itinerary. I am including a link to the Commonwealth War graves website, where you can search for the names of soldiers to find exactly where their grave is located. This can be brought to the parents evening or handed to myself at school.

Finally, it is essential that we have a photocopy of the European Health Insurance Card for each student. I know most students have already brought these in but for any outstanding cards they should be brought into school now and handed to Mrs Ball in the admin office or as last resort handed to me on the evening itself.

Otherwise, we look forward to seeing you on Wednesday 15th June at 6pm. It is worth informing you in advance that we leave at a quarter to midnight on Friday 8th July and will arrive back late on the evening of the Tuesday 12th July. Furthermore students will require around £20 in cash and a maximum of 100 Euros.
