

The order of running is as follows:

<b>Period 4: year 11</b>
<b>Period 5: year 8</b>

If you teach that year group the period their service takes place, please meet your class in the usual room, register them and bring them to the Chapel straight away (they are to leave their bags in the classroom). Could staff remain with their class for the Service (about 10 minutes). The pupils will be invited to remain behind if they would like to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation. At this stage, those that do not wish to go to Confession will return to their classroom. Teachers are to return with them and continue the lesson as normal as possible.

Apologies if this puts out any planning, for future services consideration will be given to avoid hitting the same subjects again, especially upper KS4.

If you would like to receive the Sacrament but are restricted due to teaching during the day, if you speak to any of the Priests, I am sure they will accommodate you.
