Prayer for Christian Unity: Every year, in the week that builds up to the feast of **The Conversion of St Paul**, Christians of all denominations come together and pray for unity of all Christians. The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity 2019 has been prepared by Christians from Indonesia. With a population of 265 million, 86% of whom are reckoned to be Muslim, Indonesia is well known as having the largest Muslim population of any country. However, about 10% of Indonesians are Christian from various traditions. This year the theme has been selected as 'Justice', and finds

its origins in Deuteronomy. "Justice, Only Justice, You Shall Pursue" (cf. Deuteronomy 16:20) was chosen for its powerful message of promoting truth, equality and unity.
