Dear Parent/Carer

Thank you for all of your support during the academic year in setting the correct standards of dress, behaviour and work ethic for your children. The school has a calm and positive working environment and we hope to maintain this throughout the academic year.

A great deal of work has gone into ensuring that students arrive on time and are equipped and ready to start the school day and this has borne fruit in the way lessons have been able to start quickly and purposefully.

As we approach the holidays, we thought it would be prudent to remind you of our uniform policy and expectations for September;

- Standard school trousers only (skinny fit trousers or jeans are not appropriate)
- Shirts tucked in
- Skirts should not be rolled up or shortened by being cut and re-hemmed
- Black or grey socks only (no white socks)
- Footwear – black leather school shoes only (please see list attached). We understand that some retailers sell trainer style school shoes however, these do not comply with our uniform policy
- Piercings – no more than one pair of ear piercings. Nose studs are prohibited

Any student arriving in school without correct uniform should see their Head of Year during registration. Commencing in September 2019 we will have a bank of clothes and shoes that students can borrow for a day at a time. Heads of Year will look after any non-school clothing and footwear in their locked offices and students can collect them at the end of the school day.

We are mindful of the fact that there may be some students wearing specific shoes for medical or other reasons. In this case students need not worry; a dated note in their planner to explain their circumstances or a medical note in the case of health reasons will suffice in this situation.

As an outstanding school, we pride ourselves not only on the academic achievement of our students but also on all aspects of their moral, social, spiritual, creative and sporting development. The way we are dressed and ready for learning has a huge impact on and demonstrates our attitude towards our learning and our community.

Please support us in ensuring that your child comes to school in the appropriate school uniform. If you have any challenges in this regard please contact your child's Head of Year as soon as possible.
