Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to inform you that your son/daughter has been identified as currently below target in an aspect of the English curriculum. The English department has put together a tailored intervention programme for students identified as below target in various components of the language and literature courses, in order to improve their grades. Last year we ran a similar programme with the year 11 students and the impact on their outcomes was very significant.

The English Study+ intervention programme involves sessions every Wednesday lunchtime from 12.30pm until 1pm, delivered by one of the teachers within each band of classes. Each half term there will be a different component of focus and relevant students will be invited, by letter, to attend one of the sessions each week for that half term. This half term, the focus will be **English Language Paper 2 Reading** and your son or daughter's score last year suggests this to be a component which they could really benefit from support with. Please accept this, therefore, as their invitation.

*If your son or daughter is in class 1a or 1b then they should go to **G31** at 12.30pm on Wed 18th Sep.*

*If your son or daughter is in class 2a, b or c then they should go to **F9** at 12.30pm on Wed 18th Sep.*

*If your son or daughter is in class 3a, b, c or 4a then they should go to **F12** at 12.30pm on Wed 18th Sep where this group will be split between this room and **F11** next door and between 2 teachers within these bands.*

Student attendance at these sessions will be monitored and you will be notified if your son or daughter is failing to attend.
