Dear Student and Parent/Carer

We are pleased that Year 11 students are working so well during this final assessment period and are continuing to manage the routines and adaptations necessary in school on a daily basis.

As you know, the assessment window for GCSE and equivalent qualifications runs up to half term, with the majority of assessments being scheduled up to May 14. After this date, students will have completed most of their assessments and we have therefore taken the decision to move to voluntary lessons from Monday 17 May to Friday 28 May. **Students should still come into school for planned assessments.**

These final two weeks before half term may also include catch-up assessments for students who have missed a scheduled assessment due to illness or isolation; these will be arranged with subject teachers and/or Heads of Department. All Year 11 teachers will be available in their scheduled lessons during these two weeks and will teach lessons where students attend.

Further communication will be sent to you to inform you how you can book a place for your child within school for the final two weeks.

If your child is intending to continue to the Associated Sixth Form, transition work to support their Sixth Form studies will be available on the website from Monday 7<sup>th</sup> June. It is an expectation that this work is completed before courses begin in September and handed to the subject teachers in the first week of timetabled lessons.

Please remember that your Head of Year, Form Tutor and the pastoral team are here to help and support you throughout these final weeks.
